Notes:

1. Linear buffer hedges required for all “installed on grade” equipment visible from the street.
2. Hedges used for buffering shall not exceed a height of 60”. Top-dress soil with 2”- 3” of mulch if needed.
3. Lines passing through exterior walls must be sealed to prevent moisture penetration.

Existing Irrigation Lines Check For Permanent Stand-by Systems

At owner’s expense: contact the Villas “landscaping contractor of record” to:

- locate existing irrigation lines
- relocate, cut or cap any affected irrigation lines

Documents Submitted with The ACC Application should Include:

- Lot Platt Plan, indicating the location of the unit (or pad, if permanent system).
- Contractor proposal, including: license number-insurance information/plans/drawings/sketches.
- Description/photos of unit/system.
